"a portable sanctuary in the wilderness"

In Exodus, the tabernacle for two specific purposes:

- 1. Move people into God's presence to worship.
- 2. To represent Yahweh's nearness to His people

Exodus 25:8-9

"Then have them make a **sanctuary** for me, and I will dwell among them. Make this **tabernacle** and all its furnishings exactly like the pattern I will show you."

John 1:14


"The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth."




TABERNACLE SYMBOLIZES A MODEL OF HEAVEN

Heavenly Temple




TABERNACLE SYMBOLIZES A MODEL OF EDEN

The Dry Land (Gen. 1:9-13)



- 2 Peter 2:24






THE BRAZEN LAVER


